

DUCHAMP AND CAGE

ALDEBURGH BEACH LOOKOUT

THIS AUTUMN

Aldeburgh Beach LOOKOUT is the brand new place to experience art. In addition to weekly artists' residencies, this autumn it launches *Duchamp and Cage: 100 years later*, which examines these two iconoclasts whose ideas in art and music are fundamentally linked. (See enclosed)



Because it is isolated, yet at the heart of cultural innovation, the LOOKOUT is a magical and stimulating setting for artists to respond each in their own fascinating way; and artists include Peter Blake RA, Ryan Gander, Eileen Cooper RA, Pat O'Connor, Tallulah Brown, Nigel Hall RA, Stephen Farthing RA, Cathy de Monchaux and Phillip King PPRA. Each weekly residency culminates in an exhibition of new work.

"Since I found this extraordinary tower when swimming one morning, we have been thrilled that artists, musicians, poets, performers and thinkers of all varieties have discovered the LOOKOUT as a catalyst for their ideas" Says Caroline Wiseman, founder of the Aldeburgh Beach LOOKOUT.

Opposite the LOOKOUT is the Aldeburgh Beach Art House, which is like a living Kettles Yard by the sea, yet constantly reinvigorated with new art from the residencies. As with Caroline Wiseman's houses in London and New York over the past 24 years, in every room art by many of Britain's most important modern and contemporary artists (including Terry Frost, Ben Nicholson, Fiona Banner, Tracey Emin, Craigie Aitchison, Pablo Picasso) becomes part of the household.

Duchamp and Cage: 100 years later features rare etchings by Duchamp and rare lithographs by Cage, plus works by contemporary artists inspired by these two historical greats. The Turner Prize nominee Ian Davenport RA exhibits *Staggered Lines*, Small Black (2010). Albert Irvin exhibits *Promenade* (2003). Meanwhile the Berlin based performance group mmmmm project their video piece, inspired by Duchamp's 1912 painting *Nude Descending a Staircase* onto the outside of the LOOKOUT. A full program of performance art and exhibitions takes place each weekend until Christmas.
